

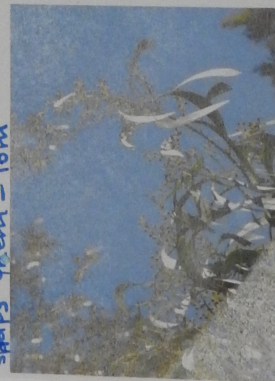


Rob from Natural Resources Management showed us around our Wirra.
