Belonging, Being, Becoming. We encourage children to Connect with Nature to:

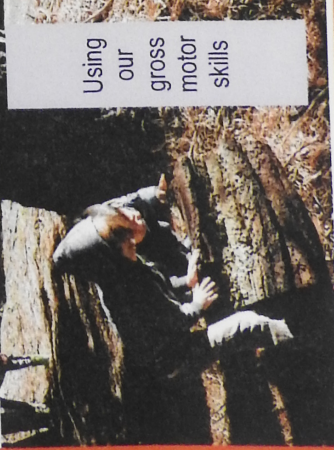

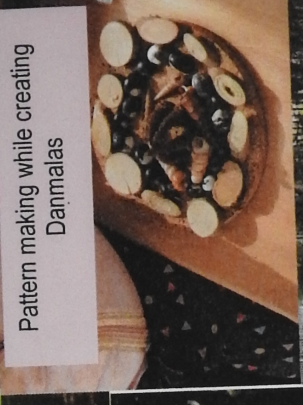

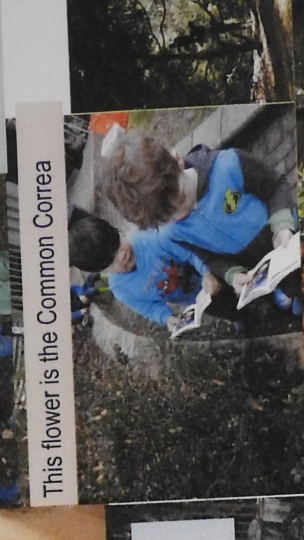
