<u>Transition to school</u>

Hayley has been in contact with most of the children's 2020 reception teachers, and arranged for one of us to attend a transition visit to provide support for your child. We should have this all finalised in the next few days. We will also be making a time with their teacher to discuss each child's strengths, interests, learning styles, dispositions and areas that would benefit from support or consideration. This information will be summarised in your child's Preschool Statement of Learning, which we will begin working on very soon.

We welcome you to make a time to chat with one of us again, as we did earlier in the year, to discuss your child's progress towards meeting their individual learning and developmental goals. We are happy to do this in person, or make a time to talk on the phone if this is easier.

Another way we would like to support you and your child is by connecting families and children who are going to the same school. Take a look at the display (inside Kindergarten) of children's photos alongside photographs of their school. For some children, their school peers are in a different kindergarten group so we will assist these families to connect.
